AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION TO APPLY TO THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION FOR AN ORDER AUTHORIZING CONSTRUCTION OF AN AT-GRADE CROSSING OF THE SACRAMENTO REGIONAL TRANSIT TRACKS FOR THE 5TH STREET EXTENSION PROJECT

## **BACKGROUND**

- A. The City has an approved Proposition 1C Transit Oriented Development Grant to fund the design and construction of the extension of 5<sup>th</sup> Street. The 5<sup>th</sup> Street Overcrossing portion has been completed, and the City intends to partner with IA Sacramento, LLC to complete construction of the 5<sup>th</sup> Street roadway extension.
- B. In order to proceed with construction of the 5<sup>th</sup> Street extension, the City requires an Order from the California Public Utilities Commission authorizing construction of an atgrade crossing of the light rail tracks.

## BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Director of Transportation is hereby authorized to apply to the California Public Utilities Commission for an Order authorizing construction of an at-grade crossing of the Sacramento Regional Transit light rail tracks at 5<sup>th</sup> and H Streets.
