RESOLUTION OPPOSING SACRAMENTO COUNTY MEASURE "O" - THE DEER CREEK HILLS BALLOT INITIATIVE ON THE NOVEMBER 7, 2000 BALLOT

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento discussed the recommended positions for the Deer Creek Hills Ballot Initiative – Sacramento County Measure "O" on the November 7, 2000 election, and

WHEREAS, the measure overrides the County's general plan and the deliberative government processes; and

WHEREAS, Measure "O" would amend the Sacramento County General Plan and Zoning Code to create a new "Senior Community" urban land use designation; and


WHEREAS, Measure "O" would enact an ordinance allowing zoning for 2,700 to 3,000 residences on approximately 2000 acres in an area adjacent to Rancho Murieta called the Deer Creek Hills Senior Community; and

WHEREAS, the Deer Creek Hills senior community would be located in an area that is known to experience some of the highest ozone levels in the region; and

WHEREAS, elderly residents are among the most susceptible to health problems from air pollution, including aggravated cardiovascular and respiratory illness, added stress to the heart and lungs, and damaged cells in the respiratory cells in the respiratory system; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Sacramento hereby opposes Sacramento County Measure "O" – the Deer Creek Hills Ballot Initiative.
