Issue Detail: The Sacramento Community Police Review Commission's ("SCPRC") Resource Allocation & Efficiency at Impacting Public Safety Ad Hoc Committee is tasked with the goals to review and evaluate the goals and key performance metrics of the Sacramento Police Department ("SPD") to measure the impacts to public safety; and provide recommendations to the SCPRC, SPD, and the City Council for future actions and policy changes related to improving public safety. This agenda item will be an opportunity for the commission to dive deeper into what the scope of this Ad-Hoc Committee might entail, including a potential review of how several SPD expenditures might be contributing or not contributing to improving public safety. Given the recent news and analysis on May 23 from the Sacramento Bee, 15 Sacramento police officers doubled their pay with overtime for multiple years: https://www.sacbee.com/news/local/article306574586.html#storylink=cpy, this will be an opportunity to provide feedback into how this issue might be incorporated within the scope of this Ad-Hoc Committee and for the SCPRC to learn more about this issue.
