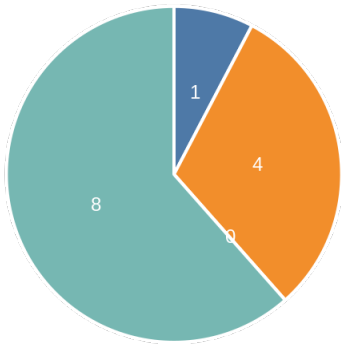

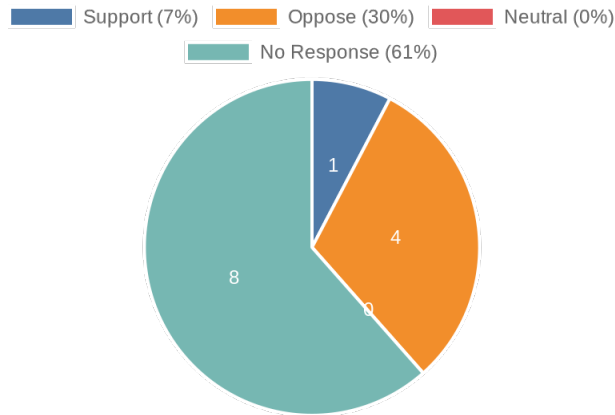

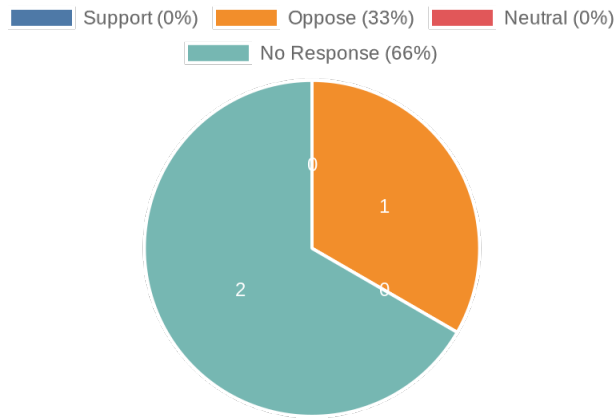

Dear Sacramento City Law and Legislation Committee Members,

Law enforcement provided forgery investigation reports is criminal activity and obstruction of justice. In 2-20-2024, my first public comment at Sacramento City Council meeting about SPD providing forgery reports for my father's death. **City Manager was there.** It has been almost one year but Sacramento City government is still not taking any action against SPD. Now, I still don't know who killed my father and don't have the statement from the person who killed my father. Below is the information about the incident.

Form SPD810 Sacramento Police Department Citizen Report Request: (see attached SPD810)

On 8-3-2023, SPD staff # 6204 filled out report numbers 99-83081 and 99-83121 on the SPD810 Form. On 8-18-2023, SPD staff # 6253 rejected the request with reason "Rpt/WC" and "WC Cantonese". In early September 2023, I picked up the form SPD810 at SPD HQ Record Office and I was given the forgery investigation report 99-83081. In May 2024, SPD Captain Brian Kinney emailed me the same forgery reports.

Forgery investigation report 99-83081: (see attached 99-83081)

Party 1, 2 and 3 are missing from the report. "#1 BOOKED" but Jone Soo Fong is "PARTY 4". SPD refused to present the report 99-83081 in front of the camera of Sacramento City Council Meeting.

I filed complaint to OPSA Director against SPD in May 2024 and to Ethics Commission against City Manger and OPSA Director in June 2024. Both City Manager and OPSA Director violated Sacramento City Code "4.02.030" "Break the public trust". However, Ethics Commission and City Clerk used "No jurisdiction" as a reason to dismiss my complaint. My father was killed in downtown Sacramento, I received the forgery reports from SPD staff inside SPD headquarters and the email from Captain Brian Kinney. Everything were happened inside Sacramento City, why Sacramento City has no jurisdiction for my complaint?

I have requested Sacramento City government to take action during the following meeting -
