### **Approve Freeway Maintenance Agreement with the State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for the South Sacramento Parkway Trail West (K15155000)**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The City of Sacramento desires to construct a Class I bike trail connecting Freeport Shores Bike Trail to the North Delta Shores Bike Trail. The South Sacramento Trail West Project will provide improvements to cross the barrier created by Interstate 5.
- B. The City of Sacramento and State of California are parties to a Freeway Agreement which defines the boundaries of State Highway Route 5 within the City of Sacramento's limits.
- C. As a condition of State approval of the Project, it is necessary for the City of Sacramento and State of California to enter into a Freeway Maintenance Agreement for Route 5.
- D. The Freeway Maintenance Agreement with Caltrans outlines the responsibilities of the City and State of California relating to maintenance issues regarding chain link fencing, bicycle paths, weed control, and legal relations and responsibilities.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

##### **SECTION 1.**

The Maintenance Agreement for the South Sacramento Parkway Trail West with the State of California, as depicted herein as Attachment 5 is approved.

##### **SECTION 2.**

The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute a Maintenance Agreement for the South Sacramento Parkway Trail West with State of California.
