FY2009/10 CITIZEN'S OPTION FOR PUBLIC SAFETY GRANT

BACKGROUND

- A. The State Citizen's Option for Public Safety (COPS) Program provides funding to local City and County law enforcement agencies for public safety purposes. The State of California has allocated \$745,298 in funding for FY2009/10 to the Police Department through the Citizen's Option for Public Safety (COPS) Program.
- B. The Police Department plans to utilize this funding to improve efficiencies in support of front-line law enforcement

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized on behalf of the City of Sacramento, to accept COPS funds in the amount of \$745,298.
- Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to make the necessary grant revenue and expense budget adjustments to implement the \$745,298 grant award.
- Section 3. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to establish a grant project (G11007000) for the FY2009/10 COPS funding.
- Section 4. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to execute any contracts, agreements or change orders necessary to implement this program.
