## SACRAMENTO CITY PLANNING AND DESIGN COMMISSION NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Community Development Department is notifying all interested parties of the proposed project (described below) that the Sacramento City Planning and Design Commission will review this proposal at a Public Hearing scheduled to begin at 5:30PM on January 22, 2026 at New City Hall, 915 1 St, 1st Floor, Sacramento, CA 95814.

Members of the public may participate in the meeting by submitting written comments electronically before and during the meeting via eComments, accessible through the City's official website at [http://sacramento.granicus.com/ViewPublisher.php?view\\_id=21](http://sacramento.granicus.com/ViewPublisher.php?view_id=21). Members of the public may also watch the meeting live online.

**TITLE:** The Enclave at Airport Road (P25-010)  
**LOCATION:** 3600 Airport Road; APN(s): 225-0150-055-0000, District 3

**PROJECT:** The applicant is requesting to demolish an existing single-unit dwelling and accessory structures to construct a detached single-unit subdivision with 32 residential dwellings and associated site improvements on a ±2.03-acre site. This request requires the following entitlements: 1) Development Agreement between the City of Sacramento and the landowner; 2) Rezone from Single-Unit or Duplex Dwelling (R-1A) zone to Single-Unit or Duplex Dwelling - Natomas Crossing Area 2 Planned Unit Development (R-1A-PUD) zone; 3) Planned Unit Development (PUD) Schematic Plan Amendment to annex the project site in the Natomas Crossing Area 2 PUD; 4) PUD Guidelines Amendment to amend the residential development standards; 5) Tentative Subdivision Map to subdivide the site into 32 residential lots and 8 common lots; and 6) Site Plan and Design Review of the Tentative Map layout, demolition of the existing structures, and construction of the single-unit subdivision in the R-1A-PUD zone. The Planning and Design Commission will make a recommendation to the City Council, who will make the final decision. A public notice will be sent in advance of each hearing.
