## **Pilot Program for Educational Institution Preferential Parking Permits**

## BACKGROUND

- A. William Land Elementary School and St. Francis High School are historically established educational institutions in Sacramento located in areas regulated by existing preferential permit parking programs for residents.
- B. Both school sites do not have sufficient off-street parking facilities to accommodate staff due to site expansions that were necessary to sustain their academic programs.
- C. California Vehicle Code section 22507(b) authorizes designation of preferential parking privileges to school personnel to park on specified streets if use of the permits will not adversely affect parking conditions for residents and merchants in the area.
- D. A pilot program to evaluate the effectiveness of educational institution permit parking on the street will require the implementation of preferential parking privileges for school personnel to park, with an exception to posted time restrictions or meter payments, at curbside spaces bordering school property.
- E. The pilot area at William Land Elementary School will include parking spaces that border the school property on 11<sup>th</sup> Street between V Street and U Street, V Street between 11<sup>th</sup> Street and 12<sup>th</sup> Street, and U Street between 11<sup>th</sup> Street and 12<sup>th</sup> Street.
- F. The pilot area at St. Francis High School will include: M Street, on the north side, from the east property line of 6001 M Street to Louis Way; Louis Way, on the west side, from M Street north to the south property line of 5900 Elvas Avenue; 60<sup>th</sup> Street, on the west side, from M Street north to the north property line of 1290 60<sup>th</sup> Street and 61<sup>st</sup> Street, on the east side, from M Street north to the north property line of 1291 61<sup>st</sup> Street.

## BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. An educational institution preferential parking permit pilot program at William Land Elementary School and St. Francis High School for school personnel is approved.

Section 2. The pilot program shall expire at the end of the 2018-2019 academic school year for both schools.
