RESOLUTION REJECTING BIDS FOR LIQUID CHLORINE, SUS-
PENDING COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND AUTHORIZING CITY
MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT FOR LIQUID CHLORINE IN
AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$280,000

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


That pursuant to Section 57.401(a) and upon recommendation
of the City Manager, no valid bids have been received for the purchase
of liquid chlorine in tank cars and cylinders and therefore all bids
are hereby rejected.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to Section 57.401(c) of
the Sacramento City Code it is in the best interests of the City of
Sacramento to suspend competitive bidding for the purchase of liquid
chlorine in tank cars and cylinders.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby
authorized to execute a contract or contracts with PPG Industries and
Continental Chemical Company for the purchase of liquid chlorine in
tank cars and cylinders, respectfully, in an amount not to exceed
\$280,000.
