Description/Analysis

Issue Detail: At its November 15, 2021 meeting, the Committee approved its priorities for the FY2021/22 Midyear Budget (Midyear Priorities). Specifically, in its Midyear Priorities, the Committee recommended "that the City brand Measure U investments in the city by directing staff to develop a logo."

City branding of Measure U programs and expenditures is an opportunity to educate and inform residents by drawing a connection between the Measure U taxes we pay, and the programs and services the City delivers. To that end, the City Manager's Office developed three Measure U logo design options (Attachment 2) and invites the Committee's feedback regarding which option it most prefers.

Policy Considerations: City Council Resolution 2018-0393 adopted October 2, 2018 outlines the purpose, and the powers and duties of the Measure U Committee. Specifically, the Resolution states, to ensure that the expenditures of City resources reflect Council and community priorities, the Committee shall review, report, and make non-binding recommendations on revenue and expenditures of certain funds from the Transactions and Use Tax (Sacramento City Code chapter 3.27.).
