

# RESOLUTION No. 137

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of  
May 18, 1933

RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT PUBLIC INTEREST AND NECESSITY DEMAND THE ACQUISITION OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY AT GRANADA WAY AND SEVILLE WAY IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO FOR A FIREHOUSE SITE AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO PROSECUTE AN ACTION FOR THE CONDEMNATION OF THE SAID PROPERTY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That public interest and necessity require that the City of Sacramento acquire a firehouse site at Granada Way and Seville Way,


That, for the said site, the public interest and necessity require that the City of Sacramento acquire all that certain piece or parcel of real property, situate, lying and being in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, and particularly described as follows:

"Lots 3 and 4 as shown on the official 'Plat of Alhambra Tract' recorded in the office of the County Recorder of said Sacramento County May 26, 1927, in Book 19 of Maps, Map No. 25, except therefrom that portion of Lot 3 described as follows:

All that portion of said Lot 3 lying Easterly of a line described as beginning at a point on the Southerly line of said Lot 3, a distance of .03 feet West from the Southeast corner of said lot and running thence North 19° 30' 45" East to the North line of Lots 2 to 8 inclusive of said subdivision."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Attorney be, and he is hereby, instructed to institute and prosecute to final judgment an action for the condemnation of the above described property.
