That the City of Sacramento, a municipal corporation, does hereby approve and accept all of the terms and conditions set forth in that certain AGREEMENT between CITY OF SACRAMENTO, a body politic and a municipal corporation of the State of California, therein called "CITY" and the STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS, therein called "STATE", covering proposed installation of a traffic signal system at the intersections of Jansen Drive and McMahon Drive with Stockton Boulevard, road III-Sac-4-Sac.

That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are hereby, authorized and directed to execute said Agreement for and on behalf of the City of Sacramento.
