Temporary Street Closures of 42 Alleys/Streets in Council Districts 2, 3, 4, & 6, Proceeding No. TSC21-0002

BACKGROUND

- A. The City previously approved the Temporary Closure of the 42 subject alleys/streets in Council Districts 2, 3, 4, and 6. This new request for Temporary Closure relates to the 42 subject alleys/streets that have previously been closed but such authorization for closure has now expired.
- B. In accordance with Section 21101.4 of the Vehicle Code of the State of California and with Chapter 12.16 of the Sacramento City Code, the City Council hereby considers approval of the temporary street closures to through vehicular and pedestrian traffic of the subject alleys/streets identified in Exhibit A of this resolution to help prevent occurrences of crime-related activities.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE RECITALS, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Based upon substantial evidence present in the record of the proceedings regarding this matter, City Council hereby makes the following findings:
 - a) Closure of the 42 subject alleys/streets to vehicular and pedestrian traffic will assist in preventing the occurrence or reoccurrence of the serious and continual criminal activity that was found to exist when the 42 alleys/streets were initially closed.
 - b) The alleys/streets recommended for closure are under the City's jurisdiction and have not been designated as a through highway or arterial street.
 - c) Vehicle or pedestrian traffic in the alleys/streets recommended for closure contributes to the criminal activities that are occurring there.

- d) The alleys/streets closures will not adversely affect traffic flow, safety on the adjacent streets or in the surrounding neighborhoods, the operation of emergency vehicles, the performance of municipal of public utility services, or the delivery of freight by commercial vehicles in the vicinity of the alleys/streets recommended for closure.
- Section 2. The temporary closures of the subject alleys/streets identified in Exhibit A of this resolution to through vehicular and pedestrian traffic are necessary for the protection or preservation of the public peace, safety, and health or welfare of the neighborhoods.
- Section 3. Under Vehicle Code Section 21101.4 of the California Vehicle Code, all temporary closures are valid for 18 months except for when this period has been extended for an additional 18 months of not more than eight additional consecutive periods by resolution.
- Section 4. The City Council approves the temporary closure of the subject alleys/streets identified in Exhibit A to through vehicular and pedestrian traffic with the following conditions.
 - a) A locking security device approved by the Sacramento Fire Department will be installed on each gate.
 - b) City departments and utility companies will have twenty-four-hour access to their facilities within the alleys/streets.
 - c) Adjacent property owners may be granted access to the alleys/streets through the security device that has been approved the City's Department of Public Works.
 - d) In the event that the traffic control device(s) requires construction by a private entity for improvements in the public rights-of-way, a revocable encroachment permit must be obtained from the Department of Public Works. The revocable encroachment permit may be issued subsequent to this Resolution but must be obtained prior to the construction of improvements in the alleys/streets.












