Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

Directing the City Attorney to Prepare an Impartial Analysis of a Sacramento City Measure Pertaining to the Sacramento Children's Fund Act of 2020, Approved by the City Council to be Submitted to the Voters at the Municipal Election to be Held on Tuesday, March 3, 2020

BACKGROUND

- A. On November 5, 2019, the City Council called for a Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, March 3, 2020.
- B. On November 19, 2019, the City Council passed resolution 2019-0439 approving for placement on the March 3, 2020 Municipal Election ballot a question pertaining to the Sacramento Children's Fund Act of 2020.
- C. On November 19, 2019, the City Council approved the text of the proposed measure to be submitted to the voters.
- D. The City of Sacramento desires to have an impartial analysis of the measure.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Council hereby directs the City Attorney to prepare an impartial analysis of the issue pertaining to the Sacramento Children's Fund Act of 2020 showing the measure's effect on existing law and its operation. The impartial analysis is not to exceed 500 words, and the City Attorney shall file it with the City Clerk no later than the date set for the filing of primary arguments (Monday, December 2, 2019, by 5:00 p.m.) for the March 3, 2020 Municipal Election.
- Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause the impartial analysis to be printed in the official sample ballot for the March 3, 2020, Municipal Election.
- Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
