RESOLUTION
ORDERING CHANGES IN WORK
FOR
IMPROVEMENT PROCEEDING NO. 5404
FLORIN PERKINS INDUSTRIAL PARK
ASSESSMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, on October 15, 1985, the City Council of the City of Sacramento passed its Resolution of Intention to Order Changes In Work for Improvement Proceeding No. 5404, and in said Resolution declared its intention to order certain changes in the work and improvements for FLORIN PERKINS INDUSTRIAL PARK ASSESSMENT DISTRICT, and

WHEREAS, this Council did in said Resolution of Intention to Order Changes In Work for Improvement Proceeding No. 5404, set October 29, 1985, as the day for hearing protests to said proposed changes.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA:

That this Council hereby finds and determines that no interested person has filed any protest against the proposed changes in the work and improvements for FLORIN PERKINS INDUSTRIAL PARK ASSESSMENT DISTRICT described in this Council's Resolution of Intention To Order Changes In Work for Improvement Proceeding No. 5404.

That this Council hereby finds and determines that the estimated cost of all the work for FLORIN PERKINS INDUSTRIAL PARK ASSESSMENT DISTRICT determined from the contractor's prices stated in its bid is \$791,592.27; that the net cost of all the proposed changes described in this Council's Resolution of Intention To Order Changes in Work for Improvement Proceeding No. 5404, is \$102,180.00; and that the cost of said proposed changes will increase the estimated cost of all work for FLORIN PERKINS INDUSTRIAL PARK ASSESSMENT DISTRICT by approximately 12.9% of the estimated cost of all work now included in the contractor's bid and said 12.9% does not exceed the limitation set by law for changes that increase the cost of the work.

That this Council hereby orders that the work and improvements for FLORIN PERKINS INDUSTRIAL PARK ASSESSMENT DISTRICT described in the following Resolutions of this Council:

Resolution No. 84-599
Resolution of Intention
adopted July 10, 1984

and

Resolution No. 84-703
Resolution Ordering Work
adopted August 14, 1984,

be changed, and that all the new work described in this Council's Resolution of Intention To Order Changes In Work For Improvement Proceeding No. 5404, be included in the work to be done for said District, and that all the work described in said Resolution that this Council declared an intention to delete from the work for said Assessment District be, and the same is hereby deleted from the work to be done for said District.

That this Council hereby orders the Superintendent of Streets to include the costs of the changes herein ordered and the incidental expenses thereof in the Assessment for the work and improvements for FLORIN PERKINS INDUSTRIAL PARK ASSESSMENT DISTRICT, and to delete the cost of deleted work from said Assessment for said Assessment District.

That this Council hereby authorizes MELVIN H. JOHNSON, Superintendent of Streets, to execute with GRANITE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, an amendment to the contract said Superintendent of Streets and said Company, as Contractor, executed on September 7, 1984, for the work for FLORIN PERKINS INDUSTRIAL PARK ASSESSMENT DISTRICT, which amendment will bind said contractor to construct the ADDITIONS TO WORK described in said Resolution of Intention To Order Changes In Work for Improvement Proceeding No. 5404, as Items A - K, inclusive, and which amendment will authorize said contractor

to delete the work from the contract that this Council described in Paragraph L under the title DELETIONS FROM WORK in said Resolution for said Improvement Proceeding No. 5404, all for the prices said contractor stated in its Consent, filed with this Council on July 30, 1985.


That the Superintendent of Streets, at the time of executing said amendment to said contract, shall require from GRANITE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, Contractor, to execute and deliver to the City of Sacramento an Additional Labor and Material Bond, and an Additional Contract Bond, duly signed by it and by a surety or sureties, all in the forms and for the amounts as prescribed by law and the contract specifications on file with this Council.

This Resolution was passed and adopted by the City Council of the City of Sacramento, State of California, this 29th day of October, 1985.
