# GRANT: PURCHASE OF FIRE DEPARTMENT SPECIALIZED RESCUE EQUIPMENT AND HAZARDOUS MATERIAL TRAILER(S) THROUGH 2015 STATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (SHSGP)

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The Sacramento Fire Department (SFD) is seeking approval to accept grant funding from the 2015 State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP) in an amount up to \$65,400 for the purchase of Specialized Rescue Equipment and up to two Hazardous Material Trailers. This is a Federal grant that is passed through the State of California and the Sacramento Operational Area and provided directly to the public safety agencies within the County of Sacramento.
- B. The purpose of the grant is to build capabilities to protect against, prevent, respond to, and recover from terrorist acts and other types of emergencies or disasters.
- C. SFD is seeking to strengthen its Technical Rescue Program with the purchase and implementation of equipment that would enhance protection of critical infrastructure/key resources and regional catastrophic incident planning, response and recovery.
- D. The total grant award is for an amount up to \$65,400. The acceptance of the 2015 SHSGP funding does not augment the Fire Department General Fund budget; nor is there any obligation on the part of the City for matching funds.
- E. The cost to purchase the equipment will be fully funded through the 2015 SHSGP grant. The cost of the Operations & Maintenance (O&M) and licensing for the Hazardous Material Trailer(s) will be through existing funds within the Fire Department's operating budget.

### BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept an amount up to \$65,400 in grant funding through the 2015 State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP) for the purchase of Specialized Rescue Equipment and Hazardous Material Trailer(s);

- Section 2. Operating grant projects, including revenue and expenditure budgets, for the 2015 SHSGP grant shall be established;
- Section 3. All eligible 2015 SHSGP grant related expenditures are accepted;
- Section 4. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to approve all conditions and terms to implement this grant and to assure adherence to all grant regulations.
