Grant: Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 Urban Area Security Initiative Program Funding

BACKGROUND

- A. The Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant, a component of the Homeland Security Grant Program, provides funding to eligible candidates through an analysis of relative risk of terrorism faced by the 100 most populous Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the United States, as required by the Homeland Security Act of 2002. The Sacramento MSA, which includes Sacramento, El Dorado, Placer and Yolo counties is the 26th most populous MSA in the United States.
- B. Allocations of the UASI grant are distributed to state administrative agencies (SAAs) that pass-through subawards to eligible candidates. The California SAA is the California Office of Emergency Services (CalOES). As the most populous municipality within the Sacramento MSA, the City of Sacramento (the City) serves as the grant manager for the Sacramento urban area.
- C. The Sacramento urban area has received an FY 2021 UASI allocation in the amount of \$3,097,000 from the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), through CalOES. As the grant manager, the City may accept the subaward on behalf of the Sacramento urban area. The subaward will be used by the urban area to continue the implementation of the goals and objectives of the UASI program.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to submit an application to the California Office of Emergency Services, for the FY 2021 UASI subaward.
- Section 2. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to accept the FY2021 UASI allocation of \$3,097,500.
- Section 3. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to establish an FY 2021 UASI operating grant project (G11016921).

- Section 4. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to adjust the operating grant (G11016921) revenue and expenditure budgets in the amount of \$3,097,000.
- Section 5. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to maintain three Full Time Equivalent (FTE) positions: 1.0 FTE Police Lieutenant, 1.0 FTE Program Analyst, and 1.0 FTE Program Manager, previously authorized by Resolution 2013-0308, and most recently maintained by Resolution 2021-0015.
