APPROVING EXECUTION OF MEMORANDUMS OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AND SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT (SMUD) FOR THE HOME PERFORMANCE REBATE PROGRAM AND THE SMALL BUSINESS ENERGY EFFICIENCY PILOT PROGRAM

BACKGROUND

- A. The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 appropriated \$3.2 billion for the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) Program, most of which (over \$2.7 billion) was distributed through formula grants on a per capita basis. The City was allocated \$4.7 million in EECBG funding.
- B. In May and November 2009, City Council adopted Resolution Nos. 2009-319 and 2009-736 approving the City's spending plan for its \$4.7 million EECBG allocation. Included in the plan were sub-grants of City EECGB funds to SMUD for the Home Performance Rebate Program (\$908,000) and the Small Business Energy Efficiency Pilot Program (\$500,000).

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) between the City of Sacramento and Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD) to sub-grant EECBG funds for: 1) the Home Performance Rebate program in an amount not to exceed \$908,000; and 2) the Small Business Energy Efficiency Pilot Program in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.
