Establish Capital Improvement Project and Transfer Funds for the Northwood School Access Improvements Project (T15186100)

BACKGROUND

- A. The Northwood School Access Improvements Project (T15186100) will provide a continuous, safe, and convenient pedestrian facility that interconnects Northwood Elementary School, the Swanston Light Rail Station, local businesses and residents. The project is needed to address pedestrian safety and accessibility in the community and closes a critical sidewalk gap in the network. The project expands on the scope of the El Camino Avenue Sidewalk Improvements Project (T15116300), an active Capital Improvement Project (CIP).
- B. The City was awarded Regional Active Transportation Program (ATP) funds in 2017 to complete the Northwood School Access Improvements Project.
- C. Of the many safety and accessibility improvements, the Northwood School Access Improvements Project (T15186100) proposed to signalize the intersection of El Camino Avenue at Clay Street. To advance project delivery of the signal, the signalization component was removed from the Northwood School Access Improvements Project (T15186100) and a stand-alone project was established – the El Camino Avenue and Clay Street Traffic Signal Project (T15166200). The signal was constructed with local funding in 2017, completing the El Camino Avenue and Clay Street Traffic Signal Project (T15166200).
- D. In order to begin Preliminary Engineering, the Northwood School Access Improvement Project needs to be established as a CIP and local funds must be transferred from the El Camino Avenue Sidewalk Improvements Project.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Northwood School Access Improvements Project (T15186100) is established.
- Section 2. The City Manager or City Manager's designee is authorized to increase the expenditure budget in the Northwood School Access Improvements Project by

transferring \$235,563 of Major Street Construction funding (Fund 2007) and \$222,531 of New Measure A Safety, Streetscape, Pedestrian and Bicycle funding (Fund 2039) from the El Camino Avenue Sidewalk Improvements Project (T15116300).

Section 3. The El Camino Avenue Sidewalk Improvements Project (T15116300) is canceled.
