FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2015/16 CITIZENS' OPTION FOR PUBLIC SAFETY (COPS) PROGRAM

BACKGROUND

A. California Government Code Sections 30061-30063 establishes a Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Account (SLESA) in each county treasury for the purpose of enhancing the efforts of law enforcement jurisdictions to improve frontline law enforcement activities. Each county is responsible for distributing funds from the SLESA amongst each city within the county in accordance with the relative population of each incorporated city.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee is authorized to accept \$750,451 in FY 2015/16 COPS Program funding from the County of Sacramento.
- Section 2. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to establish an operating grant project (G11014700).
- Section 3. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to establish the necessary operating grant expense and revenue budgets up to \$750,451.
- Section 4. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to adjust the necessary operating grant expense and revenue budgets in the FY2015/16 COPS Program (G11014700), based on actual disbursements received from the County of Sacramento SLESA.
