Description/Analysis

Issue Detail: City of Sacramento committees regularly have a standing item with an Agenda Log to organize and track items that will be considered in the future. This Agenda Log details each item and provides an estimate on when staff expects to bring the item back to the committee. Staff invites Committee members to add new items to or remove items from the Log, as needed, during each meeting.

Policy Considerations: City Council Resolution 2018-0393 adopted October 2, 2018 outlines purpose and the powers and duties of the Measure U Committee; specifically, to ensure that the expenditures of City resources reflect Council and community priorities, the committee shall review, report, and make non-binding recommendations on revenue and expenditures of certain funds from the Transactions and Use Tax (Sacramento City Code chapter 3.27.). On December 11, 2018, the City Council approved Motion 2018-0399, adopting the Committee's Operating Procedures. The Operating Procedures state that, "[i]tems supported by a majority of the members present is sufficient to insure it is on the next agenda" (Section 1.g.).
