

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2021-0276**

### **Authorizing a Local Maintaining Agency Resolution FY21-22 for the Flood Maintenance Assistance Program Under the Budget Act of 2021 Between the City of Sacramento and the Department of Water Resources**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. On June 8, 2021, the City of Sacramento submitted a grant application to the Department of Water Resources (DWR) for the 4<sup>th</sup> round Flood Maintenance Assistance Program (FMAP) Fiscal Year (FY) 2021/22 (Resolution No. 2021- 0169). DWR reviewed the City of Sacramento's application package and has determined that the City's Local Maintaining Agency (LMA) is eligible for funding and has awarded the City a not-to-exceed amount of \$550,600 for Funding Agreement No. 2022-FMAP-NA5-01.
- B. The State of California Budget Act of 2020 is replaced by the Budget Act of 2021, which requires a Local Maintaining Agency Authorizing Resolution.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to sign the funding agreement between the City and the State of California, Department of Water Resources for the 4th round FMAP FY2021/22, which enables the City to receive funding under the Budget Act of 2021.
- Section 2. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute all documents related to the funding agreement and take other actions as necessary and appropriate to secure the 4th round FMAP funding under the Budget Act of 2021.
