## **Description/Analysis**

**Issue Detail:** The purpose of ad hoc committees is to address a specified task or project that will take less than 12 months to complete. Once an ad hoc committee has existed for 12 months, it becomes a standing committee and must comply with the Brown Act's open meeting and agenda posting requirements. Ad hoc committees may have up to seven members.

On March 21, 2022, the Measure U Community Advisory Committee adopted the following Ad Hoc Committee Procedures:

Ad Hoc Committees must provide an oral report for all meetings held at the subsequent Committee meeting. Oral reports must describe the members present and topics discussed. Written reports are strongly encouraged to accompany the oral report. **Policy Considerations:** California Government Code Section 54952(b) defines a "legislative body" to include:

A commission, committee, board, or other body of a local agency, whether permanent or temporary, decisionmaking or advisory, created by charter, ordinance, resolution, or formal action of a legislative body. However, advisory committees, composed solely of the members of the legislative body that are less than a quorum of the legislative body are not legislative bodies, except that standing committees of a legislative body, irrespective of their composition, which have a continuing subject matter jurisdiction, or a meeting schedule fixed by charter, ordinance, resolution, or formal action of a legislative body are legislative bodies for purposes of this chapter.
