

RESOLUTION No. 133

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

May 4 1933


WHEREAS, within a comparatively short time a budget must be prepared by the City Manager for submission to this Council covering proposed expenditures for the year of 1934; and

WHEREAS, it is essential that every effort be made to further reduce the costs of city government; and

WHEREAS, there are certain fixed requirements either in the charter or otherwise which restrict further economies;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Manager be and he is hereby directed to submit to this Council a report which will set forth fully the present financial condition of the city, together with recommendations for any changes which are necessary and advisable to bring about better conditions.
