Purchase Agreement: Tow Services

BACKGROUND

- A. The Sacramento Police Department (SPD) and Community Development Department (CDD) have an operational requirement for tow services. On an annual basis, the City tows approximately 7,000 vehicles for various types of violations.
- B. On December 16, 2014, Council approved Resolution #2014-0417, which suspended competitive bidding and allowed the use of a Request for Proposals (RFP) process for the evaluation and selection of tow companies.
- C. The selected vendors entered into agreements with the City to provide tow services. In addition, College Oak Towing and Dollar Tow entered into separate supplemental agreements with the City to tow heavy-duty vehicles for abatement purposes with an annual not-to-exceed amount of \$80,000.
- D. There is now only one heavy-duty tow contractor available, College Oak Towing. The number of heavy duty abatement tows and cost of towing services has increased, therefore, an increase in the contract not-to-exceed amount is warranted.
- E. To authorize the recommended changes, Section 4 of Resolution #2014-0417 regarding heavy-duty abatement tows needs to be repealed by Council.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 4 of Resolution #2014-0417 is repealed.
- Section 2. Authorize the City Manager, or the City Manager's designee to enter in a supplemental agreement with College Oak Towing for heavy duty abatement tows to increase the annual not-to-exceed amount from \$80,000 to \$200,000.
