Cooperative Purchase Agreement Replacement Fuel Truck

BACKGROUND

- A. The Department of Public Works, Fleet Management Division, has a customer requirement to purchase one replacement fuel truck.
- B. The recommended purchases in a total amount not to exceed \$137,260 will be made from the Department of Public Works FY2017/18 operating budget (Fleet Fund, Fund 6501) and charged to the Fleet FY2017/18 Police Multi-Year Operating Project (MYOP) (I06110018, \$113,514) and to the State Forfeiture-Health and Safety externally funded project (E11006700, \$23,746) for replacement vehicles and equipment. Increasing the Department's FY2017/18 operating revenue and expenditure budgets in the amount of \$23,746 is necessary, as the replacement cost did not account for the manufacturer price increase. Upon completion of this budget adjustment, sufficient funds will be available to make the recommended purchase.
- C. In accordance with City Code Section 3.56.240, the City Manager, where advantageous to the City, may, by cooperative purchase agreements approved by the City Council, purchase supplies or nonprofessional services through legal contracts of other governmental jurisdictions or public agencies without separate competitive bidding by the City.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to increase the revenue and expenditure budgets in the Department of Public Works FY2017/18 operating revenue and expenditure budgets in the amount of \$23,746 (Fleet Fund, Fund 6501).
- Section 2. The use of the cooperative purchase agreement between National Joint Powers Alliance and National Fleet Auto Group (Contract No. 120716-NAF) for the purchase of one replacement fuel truck in an amount not to exceed \$137,260 is approved.

Section 3. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute the purchase specified above.
