Quicklime Purchase with Graymont Western US

BACKGROUND

- A. The Department of Utilities has an ongoing need to purchase quicklime as part of the water treatment and production process.
- B. City Code Section 3.56.230 allows the City Council to suspend competitive bidding with a two-thirds vote when the City Council determines that it is in the best interests of the City to do so. It is in the City's best interest to suspend competitive bidding for the supply of quicklime because the City has established that Graymont Western US is the only bidder after conducting the competitive bid process for multiple years.
- C. Sufficient funds are available in the DOU FY 2018/19 Approved Operating Budget to execute the agreement. There are no General Funds allocated or planned for this agreement.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Competitive bidding is suspended for Quicklime Purchase with Graymont Western US.
- Section 2. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute a Supplies Agreement with Graymont Western US for the purchase of quicklime for a one-year period through June 30, 2019, for a total amount not to exceed \$400,000.
