

RESOLUTION No. 1038

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

November 19, 1971

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF BUILDING INSPECTIONS TO DESTROY CERTAIN RECORDS WHICH ARE FIVE (5) YEARS OLD

WHEREAS, section 34090 of the Government Code of the State of California authorizes the legislative bodies of cities within the state to approve of the destruction of certain public records by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Building Inspections Division of the City of Sacramento is remodeling its office and is in need of additional space; and

WHEREAS, there exists in said office a great quantity of public records which are more than five (5) years old and which have been determined by the Director of the Division of Building Inspections to be of no further value to his Division or to the public at large;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. The Director of the Division of Building Inspections is hereby given authority to destroy any and all plumbing, mechanical and electrical permit records and application forms which are, upon the effective date of this resolution, more than five (5) years old.
2. On or after the effective date of this resolution, when any plumbing, mechanical or electrical permit record or application form shall become five (5) years old the Director of the Division of Building Inspections shall have the authority to destroy such record or application form.
3. Notwithstanding any other section of this resolution, no action shall be taken by the Director of the Division of Building Inspections pursuant hereto unless the City Attorney shall first approve of such action.
