### NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

**Agenda and Staff Reports:** The agenda provides a general description and staff recommendation; however, legislative bodies may take action other than what is recommended.

**Participation:**

Members of the public may participate in this legislative body's meetings in person only.

**Public Comment Speaker Time Limits:** In the interest of facilitating the legislative body's conduct of the business of the City, members of the public (speakers) who wish to address the legislative body during the meeting will have two minutes per speaker for Consent Calendar Items, Discussion Calendar Items, and Matters not on the Agenda for a maximum total of eight minutes per speaker per meeting. Each speaker shall limit his/her remarks to the specified time allotment.

- The Presiding Officer shall consistently utilize a timing system which provides speakers with notice of their remaining time to complete their comments.
- In the interest of time, speakers may be asked to limit their comments to new materials and not repeat what a prior speaker said. Speakers may not concede any part of their allotted time to another speaker.
- The Presiding Officer may further limit the time allotted for public comments per speaker or in total for the orderly conduct of the meeting and such limits shall be fairly applied.
- During Regular meetings the City provides an opportunity for the public to address the legislative body regarding items that are not on the agenda but within the subject matter

jurisdiction of the City. This opportunity is at the end of every Regular meeting under Public Comments—Matters No on the Agenda.

**Notice to Lobbyists:** When addressing the legislative body, you must identify yourself as a lobbyist and announce the client/business/organization you are representing.

**Assistance:** In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, if you need special assistance, a disability-related modification or accommodation, agenda materials in an alternative format, or auxiliary aids to participate in this meeting, please contact the Office of the City Clerk at 916-808-7200 or [clerk@cityofsacramento.org](mailto:clerk@cityofsacramento.org) as soon as possible. Providing at least 72 hours' notice will help ensure that reasonable arrangements can be made.


