Approving the Swanston Fountain Recirculation System Capital Improvement Project (L19012800) and Appropriate Funding

BACKGROUND

- A. A water recirculation system for the historic Swanston Fountain in William Land Park is required to solve significant maintenance and operations issues that include control of algae growth and conservation of water. Creation of a capital improvement project is necessary to accomplish this improvement.
- B. City Council approval is required to establish capital improvement projects (CIP).
- C. Utilizing funds from the Land Park Fund (Fund 2507) is appropriate for this improvement. There are adequate resources in the Land Park Fund (Fund 2507) available fund balance to fund this project.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to establish a new capital improvement project for the Swanston Fountain Recirculation System Project (L19012800).
- Section 2. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to transfer \$25,000 from Park Land Park Fund (Fund 2507) available fund balance to the Swanston Fountain Recirculation System Project (L19012800).
