RESOLUTION No. 133

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of October 6, 1944

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has made application to the Reclamation Board of the State of California for permission to install a 51 inch sewer line under the "B" Street Levee at its intersection with 18th Street, within the limits of the City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, on the 20th day of September, 1944, said Reclamation Board, by Order, granted such permission upon the condition that the duly authorized officials of the City of Sacramento execute an acceptance of the conditions of such Order,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL. OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the Mayor of the City of Sacramento be authorized to execute the acceptance of the conditions of the Order of the Reclamation Board of the State of California granting permission to the City of Sacramento to install a 51 inch sewer line under the "B" Street Levee at its intersection with 18th Street, within the limits of the City of Sacramento.
