RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO HUD FOR FUNDING UNDER HR 1718, THE JOBS BILL, AND FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF SAID FUNDS FOR SELECTED CITY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the Sacramento City Council wishes to apply for Community Development Block Grant funding under HR 1718, the "Jobs Bill"; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the following projects should be accomplished with that funding:

Community Services

- 1. Reconstruction of Tennis and Basketball Courts - McClatchy Park \$ 50,000
- 2. Installation of Booster Pump and Irrigation - McClatchy Park 12,000
- 3. Installation of Lighting on Basketball Courts - Oak Park Community Center 12,000
- 4. McClellan Park Tot Lot Construction (East Del Paso Heights) 80,000
- 5. Summer Youth Employment Program 100,000

City Engineering

- 6. Additional Assessment District Formation Assistance 40,000
- 7. Marysville Blvd., N/S Grand Avenue to Doolittle - 1 1/2" AC Overlay (East Del Paso Hgts./Del Paso Hgts.) 40,000
- 8. Grand Avenue - E/S Elm to E/Dry Creek Road - Complete Reconstruction (Del Paso Heights) 71,000
- 9. Norwood Avenue - Arcade Creek to East of South Avenue - 1 1/2" Overlay (Del Paso Heights) 55,000

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- 10. Marysville Blvd. - East of Lost Robles Avenue to North Side of Grand Avenue - 1 1/2" Overlay (Del Paso Heights, East Del Paso Heights) 72,000
- 11. Grand Avenue - East Side of Balsam to East Side of Elm - 1 1/2" AC Overlay (Del Paso Heights) 13,000
- 12. Grand Avenue - East Side of Dry Creek Road to 80 - East of Clay Street - 1 1/2" Overlay (Del Paso Heights) 8,000
- 13. Northgate Blvd. - East Levee Road to Senator Avenue - 1 1/2" AC Overlay (Gardenland) 170,000
- 14. Stockton Blvd. - Broadway to Fruitridge - Remove and Replace 2" AC with Fabric (Oak Park) 332,000
- 15. 14th Avenue - 39th Street to Stockton Blvd. - Remove and Replace 1 1/2" AC, Some Fabric (Oak Park) 44,000

Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency

- 16. Completion of "D" Street Connector (Alkali Flat) 245,000
 - 17. Design of Sidewalks, Lighting, etc., Norwood Avenue, (Del Paso Heights) 40,000
 - 18. Woodbine A/D #3A 190,000
 - 19. Meadowview Road - Fence Improvement Design 20,000
 - 20. Program Administration 39,000
- \$1,633,000

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes and directs the Executive Director of the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento, in his role as Administrator of the City Community Development Block Grant Program, to submit a Statement of Projected Use of Funds to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for \$1,633,000, reflecting the above projects, to provide the necessary assurances which must accompany that Statement, and to amend the Agency budget as necessary.

SECTION 2. The City Council further authorizes the City Manager to execute an Agreement with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, in a form acceptable to it, for administration of the aforementioned funds.
