

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that certain improvements are proposed to be done and made within the boundaries of the proposed assessment district hereinafter described.

In connection herewith, said City Council hereby finds and determines as follows, to-wit:

1. That the nature of the proposed improvement and the location and extent thereof consists of ~~improving~~ the

**Installation of Water and Sewer Mains on the Westerly One-Half of Jessie Avenue from the center line of 14th Avenue to the Southerly line of ~~Marin~~ Avenue; Southerly One-Half of 14th Avenue from the Northerly production of the westerly line of Lot 153 of Colonial Acres (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder), to the center line of Jessie Avenue; 20th Avenue from the center line of 71st Street to the Easterly Boundary of said Colonial Acres; 71st Street from the Westerly production of the Northerly line of 20th Avenue to the Southerly line of 21st Avenue; Right-of-way, 17 feet in width lying Easterly and contiguous to the Westerly Boundary of Lot 9541 "Plat of Bonniemead or H. J. Goethe Company's Subdivision No. 92" (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder), from the Southerly line of ~~Marin~~ Avenue to the Easterly production of the Southerly line of 20th Avenue,**

by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus materials; installing extra strength and standard strength vitrified clay sewer; constructing concrete manholes complete with cast-iron curbs and covers; installing asbestos cement water pipe; installing cast-iron gate, valves, tees, sleeve, reducer, plugs and fire hydrants as shown on Plan.

2. The boundaries of the district of lands proposed to be specially assessed to pay the costs and expenses of such proposed work and improvement are generally defined as follows, to-wit:

Pursuant to Streets and Highways Code Section 2822(c) reference is hereby made to that certain plat or map on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City Council of the City of Sacramento in Proceedings No. 2941 which indicates by a boundary line the territory to be included in the Assessment District and which said map or plat is endorsed "Approved by the City Council of the City of Sacramento this 12th day of March, 1953;" signed "Mayor" Leslie E. Wood .

3. That the amount and portion of the cost of such proposed improvement proposed to be paid by the City of Sacramento from any source other than special assessments upon benefited property is \$ 4,655.55 .

4. The statute under which it is proposed to conduct proceedings for the proposed improvement is the "Improvement Act of 1911", approved April 7, 1911, and the several acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto; with bonds to be issued as authorized under the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915," and the several acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto, said bonds to bear interest at the rate of four (4) per cent per annum; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Engineer is hereby directed to prepare for this Council a written Report upon the proposed improvement, such Report to contain all the information required by Section 3 of the "Special Assessment, Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931", approved June 8, 1931, and the several acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto.


