Recommendation: Pass a Resolution: 1) accepting the unsolicited proposal submitted to the City by National Security Industries & Services (formally National Security Services); 2) rejecting the qualifications statements received in response to Request for Qualifications No. Q13131061002 issued on December 5, 2012; 3) suspending competitive bidding in the best interests of the City; 4) authorizing the City Manager or the City Manager's designee to extend City Contract No. 2008-032 with National Security Industries & Services for one year with four one-year renewal options for the purchase of unarmed security guard services in a total amount not to exceed \$12,753,497 for the potential additional five-year period; and 5) authorizing the City Manager or the City Manager's designee to execute the contract supplements specified above provided that sufficient funds are available in the adopted budget of the applicable fiscal year.

Description/Analysis

Issue: The City has an ongoing requirement for unarmed security guard services for approximately 22 City facilities. The existing City contract (Contract No. 2008-032) with National Security Industries & Services will expire on March 24, 2013. On December 13, 2012 National Security Industries & Services submitted a proposal offering significant financial discounts to the City to continue providing unarmed security guard services.

Policy Considerations: The recommendations in this report are in accordance with the provisions of: 1) City Code Chapter 3.56 requiring the suspension of competitive bidding; 2) City Code Chapter 3.58 requiring the payment of a living wage for certain non-professional services contracts; 3) Administrative Policy 4101for the procurement of non-professional services; and 4) Resolution No. 2010-346 prohibiting the City from entering into any new contract to purchase goods or services from any business or entity headquartered in Arizona.

Economic Impacts: None

Environmental Considerations:

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA): No environmental review is necessary because the recommendations in this report involve the administrative activity of contracting for the purchase of unarmed security guard services, and are not considered to be a project in accordance with Section 15378(b)(2) of the CEQA Guidelines.

Sustainability: Not applicable

Commission/Committee Action: None

Rationale for Recommendation: The City has an ongoing requirement for unarmed security guard services for approximately 22 City facilities. The existing City contract (Contract No. 2008-032) will expire March 24, 2013. On December 5, 2012, Procurement Services issued Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No. Q13131061002 to solicit qualified contractors to participate in an Invitation for Bid for unarmed security guard services. On December 13, 2012 National Security Industries & Services submitted a proposal offering significant financial discounts to the City to continue providing unarmed security guard services. This report recommends rejecting the qualifications statements received in response to the RFQ, suspending competitive bidding in the best interests of the City, and extending the existing contract with National Security Industries & Services because of the high level of service provided during the original contract term and the significant financial discount offered for the recommended contract extension.

Financial Considerations: National Security Industries & Services has offered the City a proposal to continue services with significant financial discounts including a 6.9 percent reduction in the hourly billable rate, no rate increases for the next three years, and continuation of the 1 percent prompt payment discount. The proposal allows for annual rate increases of 2 percent in the fourth and fifth years of the contract. Based on these terms, the City will realize a savings of approximately \$265,000 per year.

In determining the recommended spending authority, staff reviewed the expenditure history for this service and considered future needs. The recommended not-to-exceed amount of \$12,753,497 includes a 2 percent contingency in each year to allow for increases in service needs by City departments.

Funding for unarmed security guard services will be provided by the operating budgets of the departments utilizing this service. Sufficient funding is available in the FY2012/13 budget for security services through June 30, 2013. Purchases made after June 30, 2013 are subject to funding availability in the adopted budgets for the applicable fiscal year.

Emerging Small Business Development (ESBD): National Security Industries & Services is certified with the City as an emerging/small business enterprise.

Background:

On February 26, 2008, City Council adopted Resolution No. 2008-106 awarding a one-year contract with up to four one-year renewal options to National Security Services for unarmed security guard services in a total amount not to exceed \$11,402,155 for the five-year period.

On December 4, 2012, with the end of the original contract term approaching, City Council passed a motion suspending competitive bidding in the best interests of the City and authorizing the use of a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) process to solicit qualified contractors to participate in an Invitation for Bid for unarmed security guard services.

On December 5, 2012 Procurement Services issued RFQ No. Q13131061002. Six contractors responded to the RFQ. Two contractors, National Security Industries & Services and Paladin Private Security, were determined to be pre-qualified.

On December 13, 2012 National Security Industries & Services, the current provider, submitted an unsolicited proposal to the City. The proposal offered significant financial discounts, including a 6.9 percent reduction from the current hourly rate, no rate increases for next three years, and continuation of the 1 percent prompt payment discount.

The City of Sacramento ("City") and National Security Industries & Services, 2081 Curtner Avenue, San Jose, CA 95124 ("Contractor"), as parties to that certain Nonprofessional Services Agreement designated as Agreement Number 2008-032, including any prior contract supplements modifying said agreement (said agreement and contract supplements are hereafter collectively referred to as the "Agreement"), hereby supplement and modify the Agreement as follows:

1. The Scope of Services specified in Exhibit A of the Agreement is amended as follows: the Agreement is extended one (1) year through 3/24/14.

In consideration of the terms and covenants of the Agreement, including, but not limited to, the extension through 3/24/14. City shall have four separate options, which it may exercise in its sole discretion, to extend the term of the Agreement for successive periods of one (1) year each.

- 2. Schedule of Posts and Hours amended per Attachment A
- 3. Inclusion and acceptance of National Security Industries & Services proposal dated 02/04/2013 (Attachment B)
- 4. In consideration of the additional and/or revised services described in section 1, above, the maximum not-toexceed amount that is specified in Exhibit B of the Agreement for payment of Contractor's fees and expenses, is increased by \$12,753,497.00, and said maximum not-to-exceed amount is amended as follows:

11,402,155.00 Agreement's original not-to-exceed amount: Net change by previous contract supplements: 0 11,402,155.00 Not-to-exceed amount prior to this contract supplement: 12,753,497.00 Increase by this contract supplement: 24,155,652.00 New not-to exceed amount including all contract supplements:

- 5. Contractor agrees that the amount of increase or decrease in the not-to-exceed amount specified in section 2, above, shall constitute full compensation for the additional and/or revised services specified in section 1, above, and shall fully compensate Contractor for any and all direct and indirect costs that may be incurred by Contractor in connection with such additional and/or revised services, including costs associated with any changes and/or delays in work schedules or in the performance of other services or work by Contractor.
- 6. Contractor warrants and represents that the person or persons executing this contract supplement on behalf of Contractor has or have been duly authorized by Contractor to sign this contract supplement and bind Contractor to the terms hereof.
- 7. Except as specifically revised herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect, and Contractor shall perform all of the services, duties, obligations, and conditions required under the

Agreement, as supplemented and modified by this contract supplemented and modified by the contr	ent.

Guard requests vary based on the events that are booked at the above referenced facilities. The number of guards requested is based on the stated attendance of the event, at a ratio of 1 guard for every 75 people, this can range from 1 to as many but not limited to 24 guards required. The events coordinators will try to give at least two (2) weeks' notice prior to the event. At times there may be unexpected or last minute events or cancelations. Events ending less than the scheduled hours must be paid ½ of scheduled hours.

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-XXXX

AWARDING CONTRACT SUPPLEMENTS FOR UNARMED SECURITY GUARD SERVICES

BACKGROUND

- A. On February 26, 2008, City Council adopted Resolution No. 2008-106 awarding a one-year contract with up to four one-year renewal options to National Security Services, Inc. for unarmed security guard services in a total amount not to exceed \$11,402,155 for the five-year period.
- B. On December 4, 2012, with the end of the original contract term approaching, City Council passed a motion suspending competitive bidding in the best interests of the City and authorizing the use of a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) process to solicit qualified contractors to participate in an Invitation for Bid for unarmed security guard services.
- C. On December 10, 2012 Procurement Services issued RFQ No. Q13131061002. Six contractors responded to the RFQ. Two contractors, National Security Industries & Services and Paladin Private Security, were determined to be pre-qualified.
- D. On December 13, 2012 National Security Industries & Services, the current provider, submitted an unsolicited proposal to the City. The proposal offered significant financial discounts, including a 6.9 percent reduction from the current hourly rate, no rate increases for next three years, and continuation of the 1 percent prompt payment discount.
- E. Rejecting the qualifications statements received in response to the RFQ, suspending competitive bidding in the best interests of the City, and extending the existing contract with National Security Industries & Services is recommended because of the high level of service provided by National Security Industries & Services during the original contract term and the significant financial discount offered for the recommended contract extension.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The unsolicited proposal submitted to the City by National Security Industries & Services (formally National Security Services) is hereby accepted.
- Section 2. The qualifications statements received in response to RFQ No. Q13131061002 issued on December 5, 2012 are hereby rejected.
- Section 3. In the best interests of the City, competitive bidding is hereby suspended for the purchase of unarmed security guard services.

- Section 4. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to extend City Contract No. 2008-032 with National Security Industries & Services for one year with four one-year renewal options for the purchase of unarmed security guard services in a total amount not to exceed \$12,753,497 for the potential additional five-year period.
- Section 5. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute the contract supplements specified above provided that sufficient funds are available in the adopted budget of the applicable fiscal year.
