

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-0077**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

March 12, 2019

**Agreement: Sutter Medical Center, Sacramento, Police Security Services**

**BACKGROUND**

- A. The Sacramento Police Department (SPD) has provided contract public safety services to Sutter Medical Center (Hospital) since 2014. Most recently, the City Council approved Resolution No. 2017-0061 which continued public safety services for Sutter through December 31, 2018.
- B. The SPD and the Hospital have negotiated a new agreement to provide safety and security services within the hospital and to continue the efforts of an existing comprehensive neighborhood policing program within the area encompassed by 27<sup>th</sup> Street to 30<sup>th</sup> Street and J Street to N Street.
- C. The Hospital will fund four Full Time Equivalent (FTE) sworn Police Officers for a two-year period beginning January 1, 2019 and ending December 31, 2020, in an amount not to exceed \$1,345,784.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to enter into an agreement with Sutter Medical Center in an amount not to exceed \$1,345,784 through December 31, 2020.
- Section 2. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to maintain the four FTE Police Officer positions previously authorized by Resolution No. 2014-0117 and maintained by Resolution No. 2016-0032 and Resolution No. 2017-0061.
