- (a) Board of Control Approved Claims: Wharf demolition and waste to energy plant. \$1.375 million.  
SB 2622 (Presley). Board of Control funding bill.

- (b) Sacramento County Flood Control Legislation  
SB 1604 (Garamendi). City supports. TO GOVERNOR.  
SB 2669 (Doolittle). City opposed. DEFEATED.  
AB 1751 (Leslie). City opposed. DEFEATED.
- (c) Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District.  
AB 4355 (Connelly). City council members taken off the governing board in most recent amendments. City supports. TO GOVERNOR.
- (d) Firearms. Mentally Disordered Persons. City sponsored  
AB 4077 (Connelly). TO GOVERNOR.
- (e) New Ramona Colony Assessment District. State contribution of \$480,000 in Budget Act.  
AB 2745 (Vasconcellos). SIGNED BY GOVERNOR.
- (f) PERS Merger. City sponsored bill.  
AB 3508 (Isenberg). TO GOVERNOR.
- (g) National Guard Museum.  
AB 4061 (Isenberg). DROPPED.
- (h) Rail Corridor Study: San Jose-Sacramento.  
ACR 132 (Hannigan). TO GOVERNOR.
- (i) AB 971 (Costa) High Speed Rail Corridor Study Group.  
LA-Sacramento. SIGNED BY GOVERNOR..
- (j) Mandatory Water Meters. SB 182 (Boatwright). DEFEATED.
