SUBJECT: Status Update of the City's Waste Disposal Projects.

SUMMARY:

This report provides the Transportation and Community Development Committee with the current status of the City's Waste Disposal Projects.

1. PROPOSED GRANITE QUARRY LANDFILL EIR

The Department of Public Works' Engineering Division is delineating specific items for a scope of work prior to finalizing a contract with Jones & Stokes Associates. Engineering will be coming back to the Council shortly with a report on this contract.

2. PRIVATELY FUNDED WASTE-TO-ENERGY FACILITY

The Department of Public Works has retained a consultant, Brown, Vence and Associates, to prepare the City's Waste-to-Energy Request for Proposal (RFP). Brown and Vence is evaluating specific inputs to the RFP, e.g., citizen participation, emission requirements, etc. prior to preparation of the RFP. The RFP will be available for transmittal about June 18, 1985.

3. CONSTRUCTION OF LANDFILL EXPANSION

The construction of the expanded landfill is 95% complete. The work remaining includes (1) the installation of water quality observation wells, (2) fence construction, and (3) planting of vegetation on the landfill berm. City staff is expediting the planting of the vegetation to eliminate a dust problem to some River Park homes.

As part of this report, Mr. Dave Spease, Landscape Architect, of the Parks and Community Services Department, will provide this Committee with a presentation on the vegetation to be planted on the berm. _




