SUBJECT: Status Report on Landscaping at Executive Airport (M-628)

SUMMARY:

On December 22, 1981, the City Council approved an amended Airport Layout Plan for Executive Airport which included the relocation and landscaping of the Sheriff's Air Squadron Building. The Council directed that staff report back in 90 days on the status of the landscaping, which has now been completed.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Executive Airport Master Plan, adopted by the Council in 1979, contains a detailed facilities plan known as the Airport Layout Plan (ALP). This document was amended in December, 1981, at the request of both City staff and the County Department of Airports, so as to reflect changes which have been made since its initial adoption.

One of the changes involved in this action was the relocation of the Sheriff's Air Squadron building to a new site on the southeasterly edge of the visitors' parking lot. Landscaping was recommended by staff to soften the view from the airport entrance road. The Council directed that staff report back on the status of this matter.

Both the Planning Department staff and Community Services landscape architect met in the field with representatives of the County Department of Airports and the Executive Airport administration staff. A plan was agreed upon, involving a planter across the front of the building. That has now been installed. Another part of the agreement was that the Department of Airports would investigate placing slats in a short length of chainlink fence to shield some parked cars. To date, there has been no progress on this matter, but it is not deemed to be a major concern.

A copy of the landscaping plan will be displayed on the Council Chamber walls for informational purposes.


