SUBJECT: Miller Park Overflow Parking Area - Grant Application

### SUMMARY

This report recommends authorization to apply to the State of California, Department of Boating and Waterways, for a \$255,435 grant. Grant applications are due June 1, 1986.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On March 4, 1986, the City Council authorized submittal of a \$175,000 State of California, Department of Boating and Waterways grant for the construction of the Miller Park Overflow Parking Area. Since that date, the project scope has expanded. Preliminary discussions with the Department of Boating and Waterways indicate their willingness to consider this expanded grant application.

The Overflow Parking Area will alleviate the shortage of parking for boat trailers and cars within the vicinity of the Miller Park launching ramp. The area will be landscaped and lighted with the entire project estimated at \$255,435, to be covered by the grant. Grant applications are due June 1, 1986.

### FINANCIAL DATA


The grant request and estimated cost of the expanded project is \$255,435. No City funds are required.

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RECOMMENDATION



# RESOLUTION NO.

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

RESOLUTION REQUESTING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$255,435  
FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF BOATING AND WATERWAYS FOR THE  
DEVELOPMENT OF A BOAT LAUNCHING FACILITY AT MILLER PARK

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento is desirous of improving a boat launching facility at Miller Park to meet the needs of the boaters and to provide public access to the water; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Boating and Waterways is authorized to provide grants to cities, counties, districts, and other public agencies for the construction and development of small craft launching facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has conducted an inventory of existing boat launching facilities in the area and has determined that the proposed project will not be detrimental to the operations of private boating businesses in the area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has provided a forum for comments and has determined that the proposed project is needed to provide the public with access to the waterfront. A copy of the public notice, the City Council meeting agenda, and public comments concerning the proposed project are submitted as part of this application; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has conducted a feasibility report which showed the proposed project to be engineeringly and financially feasible and economically justified; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento is willing to enter into an agreement to provide for the operation and maintenance of the proposed facilities at no cost to the State;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council, by adoption of this resolution, hereby requests that the Department of Boating and Waterways provide a grant for the purpose of improving a public use boat launching facility at Miller Park; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City agrees to accept the grant and hereby authorizes the City Manager to sign the grant agreement and accept the grant for the purpose stated above.
