- I. CALL TO ORDER: THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT THE HOUR OF 4:10 PM.
- II. ACTION ITEMS: NONE
- III. DISCUSSION:
  - A. NEW ARTS EDUCATION COMMITTEE MEMBERS
    1. FREEMAN TINNIN HAS GONE TO CHAIR THE ART IN PUBLIC PLACES COMMITTEE.
    2. SANDRA YEE IS NOW ON THE ARTS EDUCATION AND OUTREACH COMMITTEE.
    3. PAULA MUNSON WAS ELECTED AND PASSED FOR CHAIR BY THE COMMISSION.
    4. WE RECEIVED EIGHT LETTERS OF INTENT FOR NEW ARTS EDUCATION MEMBERS.
    5. MICHAEL DITTMER WILL BE A COMMITTEE MEMBER AND NO LONGER AN ALTERNATE.
    6. GUIDELINES FOR MEMBER(S) 1 PERSON OPENING
      - a. BALANCE BETWEEN GENDER, ETHNICITY, DIVERSITY OF ADMINISTRATORS, EDUCATORS, AND ARTISTS.
      - b. OF THE EIGHT PEOPLE VIEWED ALPHA BRUTON, PATRICIA D'ALLESANDRO, AND TERESA HAENGGI WILL BE INTERVIEWED.
  - B. ARTS EDUCATION SURVEY
    1. SUGGESTIONS:
      - a. SEND THE SURVEY NOT ONLY TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICTS, BUT ALSO TO THE SCHOOLS.
      - b. MAKE THE QUESTIONS MORE PERSONAL FOR THE TEACHERS , SUCH AS:  
WHEN SENDING THE SURVEY TO THE SCHOOLS DO NOT ASK BOARD POLICY QUESTIONS ASK QUESTIONS FOR THE TEACHERS. ALSO ASK HOW MANY TEACHERS TEACH ART IN THE SCHOOL AND HOW MUCH TIME IS USED FOR TEACHING ART.
      - c. POSSIBLY HAVE AN IN-SERVICE DAY FOR ART TEACHERS ONLY.
      - d. HAVE THEM ANSWER AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE ON THE SURVEY OR PUT N/A WERE IT IS NOT APPLICABLE.
    2. SIERRA NORTH ARTS PROJECT (S.N.A.P.)
      - a. S.N.A.P. IS STATE FUNDED.
      - b. 2 TEACHER REPRESENTATIVES ARE SELECTED TO ATTEND THE PROGRAM FOR EACH SCHOOL.
  - C. ALAMO RENT-A-CAR
    1. THEY WANT TO DO A PROGRAM EXHIBITING CHILDREN'S ARTWORK AT THE AIRPORT.

- a. ALAMO HAS ALREADY DONE PROJECTS LIKE THIS IN FLORIDA AND WOULD LIKE TO DO ONE AT THE SACRAMENTO AIRPORT.
2. ALAMO WILL PROFESSIONALLY HANG AND FRAME THE CHILDREN'S ARTWORK, AND THEY WILL PAY FOR A PART-TIME CURATOR.
3. ARTS EDUCATION WOULD HAVE TO COME UP WITH SOME GUIDELINES OF SELECTING SCHOOLS.
4. SINCE IT IS PUBLIC ART APP COMMITTEE WOULD ALSO BE INVOLVED.
5. THE COMMITTEE APPROVED THE PROJECT TO PROCEED WITH NEGOTIATIONS.

D. THE CHILDREN'S MUSEUM

THE CHILDREN'S MUSEUM WOULD LIKE TO WORK WITH US TO POSSIBLY COORDINATE A CHILDREN'S PERFORMANCE SERIES.

E. THE COMMUNITY SERVICE COUNCIL

THE COMMUNITY SERVICE COUNCIL PROVIDES A SECTION FOR TEEN TELE-TIPS.
