

ORDINANCE NO. 930 , FOURTH SERIES


AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZINT THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE 267 TONS ASPHALTIC CONCRETE MIXTURE WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS; AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to purchase 267 tons Asphaltic Concrete Mixture at a cost of \$959.17, plus \$28.77 sales tax, without first advertising for bids, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being this material was needed in addition to the original amount bought on contract, in order to rush the completion of the work on Capitol Avenue before the opening of the State Fair, and it was ascertained that, if additional bids were called for, the price per ton would be higher than the price in the original bid, at which figure this additional amount is being purchased.


