**SUBJECT:** Surface Recycling of Various City Streets (CC: 9726) - Fund Transfer and Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended. The Budget and Finance Committee considered the fund transfer at its meeting of March 18, 1986.

BACKGROUND

On February 11, 1986 the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project, and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on March 4, 1986. Bids received are as follows:

Granite Construction Company	\$289,415.00
R.C. Collet, Inc.	\$304,788.40
Payne-Whitney Company	\$328,386.00
Teichert Construction	\$359,780.00

The estimated date of completion of the project is August 1, 1986.

FINANCIAL


The City Council has approved \$281,000 in the Public Works Capital Improvement Program budget from Gas Tax Funds for this project. An additional \$60,000 will be needed to award the contract. These funds are available from SB300 Gas Tax Funds in Cost Center 1420 and will be transferred to this project. The engineer's estimated construction cost for the project was \$257,000.



2. Broadway - west curb 3rd Street to 15th Street
3. 35th Avenue - Freeport Boulevard to South Land Park Drive
4. Royale Road - Cormorant Way to end of Sears Parking Lot
5. Cormorant Way - Sacramento Inn Way to Silica Avenue
6. Bowling Green Drive - Keith Drive to Ethan Way
7. Leisure Lane - Royal Oaks Drive east to Cal-160 Overcrossing
8. Leisure Lane - south side Cal-160 from the beginning of new pavement to the north end of City responsibility
9. Royal Oaks Drive - Cal-160 off ramp to the beginning of the curb and gutter approximately 560' north
