SUBJECT: Combination Sewer Line Replacement in K-L Alley (PN:XB66) - Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will replace the combined sewer line in the K-L Alley from 19th to 20th Streets because the line is deteriorated and smashed under the railroad tracks to the point of blockage. The combined sewer line in 19th Street near K Street and the J-K Alley will be replaced and relocated slightly because the existing line is deteriorated and the relocated line will provide improved drainage.

On November 15, 1988, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on December 6, 1988. The bids received were:

It is recommended that the City Council accept the low bid of RAMCON in the amount of \$43,408, and award the contract.


