SUMMARY:

The City Engineer's office has prepared plans and specifications for the subject project. Copy of said plans and specifications has been forwarded to the City Clerk and approval is recommended.


FINANCIAL:

In F.Y. 1977/78 the City Council approved in the Engineering Department's Budget \$270,500 for the construction of Fire Station No. 15. Total amount currently available is \$226,652. The current estimated construction cost for this portion of the project is \$45,756.


RECOMMENDATION:
