

# ORDINANCE NO. 89-001

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

JAN 3 1989

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION  
LIMITATIONS ESTABLISHED BY ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER  
62 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AND  
DECLARING THE ORDINANCE TO BE AN EMERGENCY  
ORDINANCE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

## SECTION 1.

Article II of Chapter 62 (§§62.100-62.199) of the Code of the City of Sacramento is hereby repealed in its entirety.

## SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance to take effect immediately. The facts constituting the emergency are: Proposition 73, which amended the State Political Reform Act (Government Code §§81000, et seq.) and which contains provisions that actually or potentially conflict with the provisions of Article II of Chapter 62, took effect on January 1, 1989. Given the possibility of conflict and the potential confusion of candidates for Council positions, it is necessary and appropriate to eliminate the conflicts between the provisions of the City Code and the Political Reform Act at the earliest date.
