SUBJECT: **PARKING REGULATIONS ADJACENT TO THE CANNERY
BUSINESS PARK**

LOCATION: C Street and 35th Street

COUNCIL DISTRICT: 3

SUMMARY

This report recommends that two-hour parking time limit regulations, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, be implemented on residential streets adjacent to the Cannery Business Park located at 35th and C Streets.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the attached resolution be adopted to implement, "two-hour parking from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday", time limit regulations on the following streets adjacent to the Cannery Business Park:

C Street, south side, from the west property boundary of 3432 C Street, to the east property boundary of 3528 C Street

35th Street, west side, along the frontage of 3340 C Street

35th Street, east side, along the frontage of 319 35th Street

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The residents along C Street and 35th Street have experienced increasing parking congestion in front of their homes. Curbside parking on C Street and on 35th Street near the intersection of C Street is at capacity from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. A petition, which represented 100 percent of the dwelling units, was received from residents who reside on C Street from 150 feet west of 35th Street, to 200 feet east of 35th Street, and on 35th Street from C Street south 100 feet. The petition requested that this portion of C Street and 35th Street be regulated with two-hour parking time limits from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The entrance to the Cannery Business Park is on the north side of C Street near 35th Street. Although the Cannery Business Park has adequate employee parking, employees choose to park on the residential streets. The business park management has worked with area residents and requested that employees use the available off-street parking. The business park is supportive of the proposed parking time limits.

The parking congestion extends beyond the area proposed for parking time limits. However, other area residents and small business owners do not have adequate off-street parking and, therefore, are reluctant to support extending the parking time limits beyond what is proposed.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is \$200 for the installation of regulatory signing. Funds are available in the Traffic Signs and Marking Operation Budget.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This recommendation is consistent with Sacramento City Code 25.109, which provides for parking time limits when signs are in place accordingly as authorized by resolution of the City Council.





A RESOLUTION LIMITING PARKING DURING CERTAIN HOURS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Whereas, pursuant to Section 25.109 of the Sacramento City Code, when authorized signs have been placed by the Parking Administrator giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand, or park any vehicle in a business district or on a street designated by resolution during the days and hours indicated on such signs for a period of time longer than specified on such signs.

Therefore, signs shall be posted and there shall be two-hour parking time limits from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, on the streets as follows:

C Street, south side, from the west property boundary of 3432 C Street, to the east property boundary of 3528 C Street

35th Street, west side, along the frontage of 3340 C Street

35th Street, east side, along the frontage of 319 35th Street

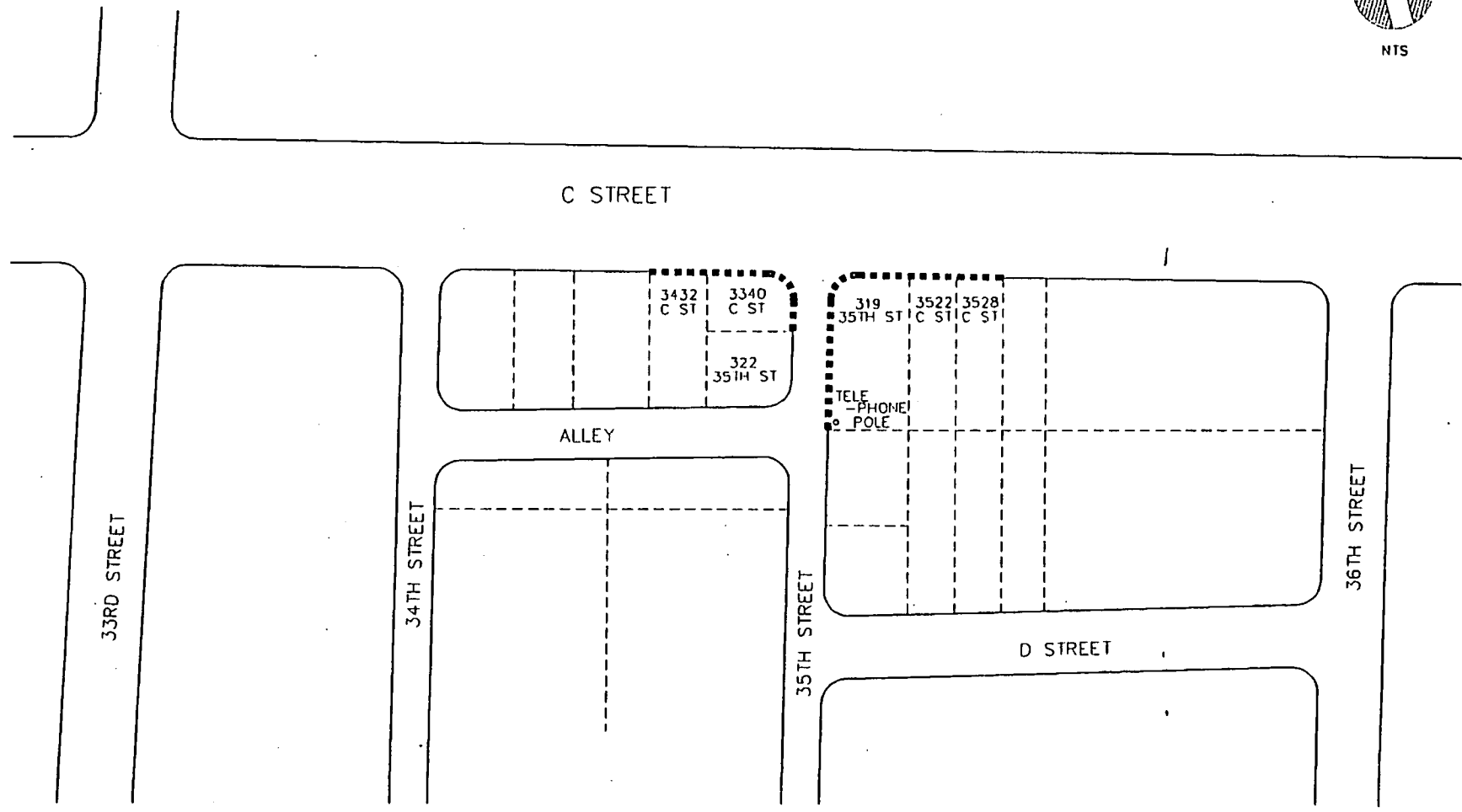
