Approval of Plans and Specifications for the Orang-Utan Exhibit

at the Sacramento Zoo

SUMMARY:

The City Engineer's office has prepared plans and specifications for the subject project. Copy of said plans and specifications has been forwarded to the City Clerk and approval is recommended.

BACKGROUND:

The subject project will provide a more natural habitat for the Orang-Utans, which are normally arborial primates. (Tree dwellers). It will also provide the viewing public a better opportunity to observe the actions of the animals in that habitat.

FINANCIAL:

In F.Y. 1981-82, the City Council approved in the Community Services' Budget, \$438,816.00 for the construction of the subject project. The sources of funds are: Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant and a contribution from the Sacramento Zoological Society. The amount currently available for this project is \$438,507.13. The engineer's estimated construction cost for the project is \$318,700.00.

RECOMMENDATION:

The City Engineer recommends that the plans and specifications be approved and that bids be received on September 7, 1982.
