

ORDINANCE NO. 608, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE SQUARE SITUATED BETWEEN
"P"- "Q", 9-10 STREETS AS "FRANKLIN D. ROOSEVELT PARK."

WHEREAS, the public square belonging to the City of Sacramento and situated between "P"- "Q", 9-10 Streets heretofore, by Ordinance No. 147, given over for the use of the Board of Education of Sacramento, has been abandoned by said Board of Education, and

WHEREAS, said square is being developed into a public park, and

WHEREAS, it is the custom to name public parks after distinguished Americans,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The public square situated between "P"- "Q", 9-10 Streets of the City of Sacramento shall hereafter be known and designated as "Franklin D. Roosevelt Park".
