<u>Grant Union High School Tennis</u> Courts - Agreement Approval



SUMMARY

This report recommends that the City Manager be authorized to execute a joint use agreement with Grant Union High School District for the six lighted tennis courts constructed by the City on District property.

BACKGROUND

The City Council approved construction of the six lighted tennis courts in FY 1979-80. The project is partially funded by a Federal Land and Water Conservation grant and under conditions of the grant, the City must enter into a 25-year joint use agreement with the District. This agreement will provide for the "joint use as a physical education and community recreation area." In addition, the agreement provides that the School District shall own, operate and maintain the facilities constructed and shall allow the City fee-exempt usage of the tennis courts for tournaments and instruction.

FINANCIAL DATA

This project was approved in fiscal year 1979-80 as a Capital Improvement Project in the amount of \$195,000.
