Declaration of Intent to Modify the Alkali Flats Residential Permit

Parking Program

SUMMARY

This report recommends the adoption of a Resolution of intention to delete certain street segments from the Residential Permit Parking Program for the Alkali Flats Area.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On March 2, 1982, the Council heard staff's report recommending the deletion of certain street segments from the Alkali Flats Residential Permit Parking Program. In response to the Council's direction, staff has prepared a Resolution for declaration of intent to delete the designated street segments, setting forth the procedures that will be undertaken to provide public notice for these program changes, pursuant to Section 25.188 of the Sacramento City Code. (Included in the attached Resolution is a correction for 14th Street.)

FINANCIAL DATA

An amount of \$9,150 has been funded by Council for implementing the Alkali Flats Residential Permit Parking Program. No change in this amount will result from the proposed modifications.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the attached Resolution, setting forth the Council's intention to delete certain street segments from the Alkali Flats Residential Permit Parking Program, be adopted by the Council.

RESOLUTION NO. 82-190

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO DELETE CERTAIN STREET SEGMENTS FROM THE ALKALI FLATS RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has established by Resolution No. 81-416 a Residential Permit Parking Program for the Alkali Flats Area, designating certain public streets within the area boundaries, as shown on the attached map, as regulated by parking restrictions;

WHEREAS, the City Traffic Engineer has re-surveyed the area and determined certain street segments as currently warranting deletion from the Alkali Flats Residential Permit Parking Program;

WHEREAS, the Planning and Community Development Committee has reviewed the proposed modifications to the Alkali Flats Residential Permit Parking Program and recommends the street segments listed below be deleted from the plan;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City Council intends to delete the following street segments from the Alkali Flats Residential Permit Parking Program, pursuant to Section 25.188 of the Sacramento City Code:

E Street, south side, from ½ block west of 12th Street to 12th Street; E Street, south side, from 14th Street to ½ block west of 15th Street; G Street, south side, from ½ block west of 15th Street to 15th Street; 8th Street, west side, F Street to alley south of E Street; 8th Street, east side, E Street to alley south of E Street; 11th Street, east side, G Street to alley south of F Street; 14th Street, east side, E Street to alley south of E Street;

The City Clerk is directed to give notice of a public hearing to this effect in accordance with City Code, Section 25.188, to be held at 7:30 p.m., March 30, 1982, in the Council Chambers, second floor of City Hall, 915 I Street.

15th Street, west side, G Street to alley south of F Street.
